1. Application Process

2. Eligible Applicants

- a) *I understand from the application that funding is available to non-profit organizations that serve the entire state. My organization concentrates most of our educational efforts on just over 60% of the state. However, we do not limit our education efforts from the other 40%. Would it be disqualifying to not have a history of concentrated efforts in the other 40%, but we know that the other 40% has still benefited from our website and public service announcement efforts? We are available to help anyone from the entire state and would plan statewide outreach for these grant activities.*

Answer: Per Section 4, Eligible Applicants, as you have noted “to be eligible for funding, the applicant agency must be a nonprofit corporation within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that serves a statewide population...” If you are able to show how your agency serves a statewide population and meets the additional requirements, also outlined in section 4, you would meet the criteria for an eligible applicant.
