- Add current arrest information
- Capture and record finger and palm print, facial images, scars, marks, tattoos, etc.
- electronically transmits all data to PSP central repositories, Web CPIN, AFIS, CCHRI, Facial Recognition System
- Present all information to the District Justice for preliminary arraignment while the arrestee is being held
- Allows the officer to immediately return to patrolling his community



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- increase public safety and productivity by verifying suspects identity and returning officers to patrol
- running records against state and federal databases for increased homeland security
- saves money on offender transportation
- saves money on booking staff salaries – officer pay vs. civilian employee





- Officers & Investigators play the biggest roles in collections

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“BLIND HIT”

- Cases being BLIND HITS where no other investigative leads available
- At the time of the crime being reported zero solvability
- Case remained “active UCR” with no follow-up
- Only factor leading to arrest or closure was DNA











Biometric Devices





About PFAD

In October 1994, Governor Robert Casey signed into law Act 85, a bill providing extensive amendments to Pennsylvania's Protection From Abuse Act, which included the legislative mandate for a statewide protection order registry, operated by the Pennsylvania State Police (PSP).

In May 1996, PCADV submitted to the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD), a concept paper and preliminary budget for a 3-year project to establish a Pennsylvania PFA Database. The information contained in those documents was subsequently included in PCCD's application for National Criminal History Improvement Program funding for Fiscal Year 1996. That funding was granted and the Protection From Abuse Database Project began in February 1997.

Since that time, PCADV has developed and implemented PFAD, an electronic statewide database. PFAD's mission is to establish and maintain a database that includes all PFA proceedings in the Commonwealth. It is a computer archival system designed to complement the operation of the Pennsylvania State Police Protection Order Registry.

This archival database automates the PFA process in the courts; provides critical statewide data for analysis by the courts and law enforcement; creates and disseminates the PSP Protection From Abuse Summary Data Sheet - information necessary for inclusion in the PSP Registry; and contains all standardized PFA forms approved by the Pennsylvania Supreme Court as well as other forms necessary for protection from abuse cases. PFAD is currently working on developing and implementing electronic forms for Indirect Criminal Contempts. Records from PFAD are immediately available 24 hours a day/365 days a year to authorized users (includes courts, legal agencies and the private bar) via a SECURED Internet website.

Due to PFAD's experience in developing this web-based database, other states have requested technical assistance as they begin to launch their own databases.

- **As of June 30, 2016, a total of 1,330 law enforcement officers and justice practitioners (includes probation officers) have been certified in CIT (40 hour curriculum);**
- **An additional 564 law enforcement and justice practitioners have been certified in Mental Health First Aid (8 hour curriculum);**
- **A total of 1,229 adults and juveniles have been diverted from incarceration or placement; and**
- **To date, 32 veterans have been diverted from incarceration.**





What is SAVIN?

- Statewide Automated Victim Information Notification (SAVIN)
 - A free service that lets you register for notification when an offender is released, transferred or escapes from a county or state prison.
- Notification can occur either by telephone, e-mail and/or text.

How Does SAVIN Work?

- APPRISS, located in Louisville, KY, is the vendor that provides the SAVIN service in Pennsylvania.
- Offender custody information is stored at the Communications Center in Louisville, KY.
- County Prisons send data every 15 minutes, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Entries into the Jail Management System will be sent to Appriss. These trigger the notifications to the registrants.

Types of Notifications

- Release, Escape, Appeal, Bail
- Unsupervised Custody, Work Release, Alternative Housing, Furlough
- Transfers
- Death
- Return to Custody: Violation of Probation, Work Release, Return Medical, Return Escape

SAVIN & Law Enforcement

- SAVIN is a tool for Law Enforcement as first-responders.
- Officers provide the victim with information on registering for PA SAVIN.
- In situations where an offender is being held in jail after an arrest, it is important to let the victim know to register within an hour or so of the offender's being taken to jail to allow time for intake to be done, so that notification of release can be made.
 - This is essential because an inmate can make bond within hours of arrest.
- An offender does not have to be sentenced in order for a registration to be done. He or she needs only to be booked into the jail.

SAVIN & Law Enforcement (con't.)

- Police and Probation/Parole Officers can also register to keep track of offenders.
- SAVIN is useful for monitoring gang and offender activity, determining whether or not certain actors are incarcerated, and finding out the location of the prison where the offender is being held.
- Officers can receive notifications if they or their families have been threatened.
- The whereabouts of an offender can be confirmed before attempting to serve a warrant.

- representing the rights and interests of crime victims

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Who is eligible to be registered with OVA?

- Direct victims
- Parents/legal guardians of minor victims
- Parents/legal guardians of incapacitated adult victims who have power of attorney
- Family members of homicide victims
- Others on a case by case basis
- Domestic violence victims, who are not direct victim of crime, to receive notifications only



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Confidentiality

- Under PA Law all victims who register with the OVA are entitled to absolute confidentiality in any and all communications.
- Status of registration is never released without consent of the victim.
- Offenders and outside entities never know of victim involvement in a case, only OVA staff is privy to this information.



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Those Not Eligible to be Registered:

- Can still be provided with public information

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When do victims become registered?

- At the time of sentencing
- When the District Attorney receives notice of an offender's parole eligibility
- By referral from:
 - Department of Corrections
 - Pennsylvania Board of Probation and Parole
 - Victim Witness
 - Domestic Violence or Sexual Assault Program



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How Can You Assist in Victim Registration?

- When a victim calls your office regarding a state offender's status, also refer them to our office.
- When the your office receives notice of an offender's parole eligibility refer the victim to our office to give input.
- Call us with your questions about inmate location and sentence
- Encourage victims to call our office to verify their registration
- Utilize our online registration process once it launches.



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Why should victims register?

- Provide input into the parole process
- Receive notification of parole status, violations and escapes/recaptures
- Receive notification of execution warrants and stays
- Receive notification from Board of Pardons
- Registrations are voluntary and confidential

It's important to remember:

- Make sure crime victims know that just because they are registered for county SAVIN or they are in touch with V/W Services, this does not mean they are registered for OVA. If they're unsure if they are registered with OVA, please have them call or call OVA for them.
- Unlike the county SAVIN notification, state SAVIN notifications are **delayed by at least 24 hours**. This is yet another reason why its so important to make sure that crime victims are registered with OVA, so that we may provide them with release information and commenting options before the actual release occurs.

Things to Remember

When speaking to a victim anytime after sentencing, make sure they:

1. Are registered with OVA
2. Know that state SAVIN notifications are delayed, NOT immediate like county (except for escapes)
3. Contact OVA with any change of address or phone number
4. Have a 4 digit pin # that is easy to remember for the phone notifications (the phone notifications will continue to call until they enter their 4 digit pin)
5. Texting is now an option for SAVIN notifications (and may be less intrusive than the phone calls)




