2011 TRAIN THE TRAINER PROGRAM

The Deputy Sheriffs' Education and Training Board (DSETB) is pleased to announce the 2011 training schedule for the Train the Trainer Program. This voluntary program is designed to develop in-house trainers that will be certified by the (DSETB) to train Pennsylvania Deputy Sheriffs across the Commonwealth. Each Sheriff's office may elect to participate and send the staff they would like to develop as a trainer.

The Train the Trainer Program is comprised of an Instructor Development Course and content-specific courses. As a prerequisite to registering and attending any content-specific course, each candidate must complete or have previously completed any of the DSETB sponsored Instructor Development Courses. Instructor Development Courses were previously held in December 2008 and March 2009. To date, the DSETB has sponsored one content-specific course, the Firearms Instructor Course, which was held in May 2010.

An Instructor Development Course is being held in Monroeville, PA on March 9, 2011 through March 11, 2011. Registration is available using the Deputy Sheriffs' Information System (DSIS). The course code is M-11-01. Class size is limited to twenty (20) deputies. The registration deadline is February 25, 2011. The DSETB will provide reimbursement for salary, lodging, mileage and meals. Upon course completion, a Training Expense Voucher will be mailed to the sheriff.

The DSETB is sponsoring two Firearms Instructor Courses during 2011. The course dates are:

June 6, 2011 through June 10, 2011 – DSIS Course Code M-11-02

September 12, 2011 through September 16, 2011 – DSIS Course Code M-11-03

These courses are being hosted by the Deputy Sheriff's Training Academy, State College, PA. Registration deadline for the June 2011 course is March 25, 2011. Registration deadline for the September 2011 course is June 24, 2011. Class size is limited to twenty (20) deputies. Ammunition will be provided. You will be contacted to provide us with your make, model and caliber of duty weapon you will be using. Lodging and meals will be provided by the academy. The DSETB will provide reimbursement for salary and mileage through issuing Training Expense Vouchers. Any Deputy Sheriff that previously completed the Firearms Instructor Course is not required to repeat the course. A separate Re-Certification Course will be offered in 2012.

In addition to the Firearms Instructor Courses, the DSETB is sponsoring a Patrol Rifle Instructor Course. This is the first offering of this course. As a prerequisite to attending the Patrol Rifle Instructor Course, the deputies must have successfully completed the Firearms Instructor Course. The Patrol Rifle Instructor Course is being hosted by the Deputy Sheriff's Training Academy, State College, PA. Patrol Rifles will **not** be supplied. Ammunition will be provided. You will be contacted to provide us with your make, model and caliber of patrol rifle you will be using. Lodging and meals will be provided by the academy. The DSETB will provide reimbursement for salary and mileage through issuing Training Expense Vouchers. The Patrol Rifle Course dates are:

September 26, 2011 through September 28, 2011 – DSIS Course Code M-11-04

The course registration deadline is June 24, 2011. The Patrol Rifle Instructor Course is limited to twenty (20) deputies.
