**Deputy Sheriffs' Education and Training Board
Train the Trainer Program**

UPDATE

The Deputy Sheriffs' Education and Training Board (DSETB), through Training Bulletin number 116 (February 2012), announced the 2012 Train the Trainer Program course schedule.

There has been a change in the training dates for class M-12-02, the Instructor Development Workshop, originally scheduled for October 8th, 9th, 10th, 2012, Monroeville, PA. This class will now be held **August 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 2012**. This class was moved to allow attendees the opportunity to attend the September Firearms Instructor Course and/or the September Patrol Rifle Instructor Course. Registration is to be completed using the Deputy Sheriffs' Information System (DSIS). Class size is limited to twenty (20) deputies.

As a reminder, successful completion of the Instructor Development Workshop is a prerequisite to attending the Firearms Instructor Course. Also, successful completion of the Firearms Instructor Course is a prerequisite to attending the Patrol Rifle Instructor Course.

Bulletin number 116 noted the deadline for registration for the September Firearms and Patrol Rifle Instructor classes is July 1, 2012. If you are attending the August 2012 Instructor Development Workshop, you may register for the September classes, but your attendance is contingent on your successful completion of the Instructor Development Workshop.

2012 TRAIN THE TRAINER PROGRAM

The Deputy Sheriffs' Education and Training Board (DSETB) is pleased to announce the 2012 training schedule for the Train the Trainer Program. This voluntary program is designed to develop in-house trainers that will be certified by the (DSETB) to train Pennsylvania Deputy Sheriffs across the Commonwealth. Each Sheriff's office may elect to participate and send the staff they would like to develop as a trainer. Deputies must have the approval of their Sheriff to be eligible for participation.

The Train the Trainer Program is comprised of an Instructor Development Course and content-specific courses. As a prerequisite to registering and attending any content-specific course, each candidate must complete or have previously completed any of the DSETB sponsored Instructor Development Courses.

The Instructor Development course in Grantville (M-12-01) will be held at the Holiday Inn Grantville, 604 Station Road, Grantville, PA 17028, (717) 469-0661. The second course (M-12-02) will be held at the Holiday Inn Monroeville, 2750 Mosside Blvd., Monroeville, PA, 15146, (412) 372-1022. Registration is available using the Deputy Sheriffs' Information System (DSIS). Class size is limited to twenty (20) deputies. Arranging travel, lodging and meals are the responsibility of the attendees. The DSETB will provide reimbursement for salary, lodging, mileage and meals. Upon course completion, a Training Expense Voucher will be mailed to the sheriff.

The Firearms Instructor Courses are being hosted by the Deputy Sheriff's Training Academy, State College, PA. On the first day of class, attendees are required to pass a qualification course of fire to remain in the course. Class size is limited to twenty (20) deputies. Ammunition will be provided. You will be contacted to provide us with your make, model and caliber of duty weapon you will be using. Lodging and meals will be provided by the academy. The DSETB will provide reimbursement for salary and mileage through issuing Training Expense Vouchers. Any Deputy Sheriff that previously completed the Firearms Instructor Course is not required to repeat the course. A separate Re-Certification Course is being required to maintain certification.

The Firearms Instructor Re-Certification Course is a two day class that deputies are required to complete once every two years. Any deputy that was certified as a Firearms Instructor by the DSETB during 2010 is required to successfully complete one of the Re-Certification Courses during 2012. Deputies that were certified during 2011 are permitted to attend, but are not required to re-certify until 2013. Priority will be given to those deputies that were certified in 2010. The Re-Certification courses are being hosted by the Deputy Sheriff's Training Academy, State College, PA. Class size is limited to twenty (20) deputies. Ammunition will be provided. You will be contacted to provide us with your make, model and caliber of duty weapon you will be using. Lodging and meals will be provided by the academy. The DSETB will provide reimbursement for salary and mileage through issuing Training Expense Vouchers.

The Patrol Rifle Instructor Course is a three and a half day course being hosted by the Deputy Sheriff's Training Academy, State College, PA. As a prerequisite to attending the Patrol Rifle Instructor Course, the deputies must have successfully completed the Firearms Instructor Course. Attendees must pass a qualification course of fire to remain in the course. Patrol Rifles will **not** be supplied. Ammunition will be provided. You will be contacted to provide us with your make, model and caliber of patrol rifle you will be using. Lodging and meals will be provided by the academy. The DSETB will provide reimbursement for salary and mileage through issuing Training Expense Vouchers.
