Court Security Instructor Training (Train the Trainer Program)

The Deputy Sheriffs' Education and Training Board (DSETB) is pleased to announce the expansion of the Train the Trainer Program to include the Court Security Instructor Training.

As a prerequisite to registering and attending the Court Security Instructor Training, each candidate must complete or have previously completed any of the DSETB sponsored Instructor Development Courses.

The Court Security Instructor Training will be hosted by Temple University. This is a three (3) day/twenty-four (24 hour) course. The course is comprised of five (5) training modules. The modules include: Courthouse Entry Security Procedures, Courtroom Security and Safety, Critical Incident Response, Hostage Response, and Improvised Explosive Device (IED) Response.

This training is being offered once in 2014. Additional classes will be scheduled based on interest. The training will be held June 2, 2014 through June 4, 2014, in State College, Pennsylvania. Registration is to be completed using the Deputy Sheriffs' Information System (DSIS). The course code is M-14-17. Class size is limited to twenty (20) deputies. There is no registration fee. Lodging, meals, mileage, and salary will be eligible for reimbursement in accordance with the DSETB Policy. Training Expense Vouchers will be issued after the completion of each class.
