## Pennsylvania State Police (PSP) Applicant Fingerprint Card

Commission policy requires that, purs uant to 61 Pa.C.S. §6307(4), before a Probation / Parole Officer who has been authorized by their county to carry firearms in conjunction with their employme nt can be certified to carry they must have had their fingerprints submitted to the PSP for a background investigation and received a favorable result.

In order to initiate this process, count ies need to contact the P SP to request a Form SP 4-124 PENNSYLVANIA STATE PO LICE APPLICANT FINGERPRINT CARD. A PSP Applicant Card submitted ens ures that the candidate has not been convicted of an offense graded a mi sdemeanor of the first degree or greater or punishable by a term of imprisonment of more than two years (without a waiver from the ATF) in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

An FBI Ap plicant card ( **Form FD-258**) should be completed the same as the state card, with "Law Enforcement" listed in the Reason Fingerprinted block. The results of the state and federal checks will be sent to your office for retention.

When contacting the PSP for this purpose be prepared to: 1) inform them you are required, under ACT- 158 of 1994, to have your officers fingerprinted for the purpose of a background investigation, and 2) provide them your ORI number.
