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1. Eligible Activities

a) It appears that the requirement for this grant is that it results in online training in all subject areas. Is there also an expectation that in-person training be offered? If in-person training is permissible, are travel, lodging, and meal expenses for trainers (and possibly attendees) allowable?

Answer: The Department of Human Services' application that supports this funding specified that the project involves the development of an on-line training for mandated reporters and first responders conducting minimal facts interviews with children with verbal, cognitive, and/or physical disabilities. Therefore, costs associated with the development and hosting of an in-person training is not allowable.
