Training Classes Cancelled

All training classes have been cancelled except for the 4-Hour online subject, Reacting to Witnessed Criminal Behavior. Successful completion of the 4-Hour online subject will still be required to maintain your certification through 2021. The 4-Hour online subject must be successfully completed by Friday, December 4, 2020 at 4:00 pm.

Once Program Staff are back to work at the office we will reassess if we can provide any additional Basic Training or Basic Firearms courses during the remainder of the year.

It is important that you activate your Temple Canvas account in order to gain access to the required 4-Hour online subject listed above. Keystone Login Issues

If you previously contacted Program Staff regarding Keystone Login migration issues, Program Staff are working their way through the calls and emails. There are at least 30 issues that they are currently working on but please check your email accounts over the next couple of weeks for information regarding your Keystone accounts. **Program Staff will not be placing phone calls to these individuals but only communicating through email.**

Currently over 200 active constables and deputy constables have not registered with Keystone Login. It is very important that this is done so that the Program has the most up to date email address information to communicate training updates regarding certification and also online training requirements.

CETB Meeting

The May 14, 2020 Board meeting will be tentatively rescheduled to Thursday, June 11, 2020 at 9:00 am. This meeting may be conducted remotely via Skype and Program Staff will relay more information as soon as it is available.

Online Training Updates

Program Staff have had questions regarding the online grades for 2020, below are some updates:

1. If you are currently enrolled into a Continuing Education class that has been cancelled but you completed the 4-Hour online subject, your class grades will be showing as “In Admin Revision”.
2. If you are currently enrolled into a Continuing Education class that has been cancelled and you have not completed the 4-Hour online subject, you must complete this online subject by December 4, 2020.
3. If you are not enrolled into a Continuing Education class but have completed the online training, this class grade will not show up in CCETS at this time. Staff is working on a solution to record the online grade in each constables' training record.

Program Staff are working on resolving these issues and will provide updated information as it becomes available. However, we need to ensure that everything is done correctly to avoid any issues with any necessary changes to policies and procedures.

Action Items for the Board

The Board will be working on issues related to firearms certification for 2021 and how to accommodate constables who are not currently firearms certified. Program Staff will be working on these issues and others for the Board's action and all Board action will need to be reviewed and approved by the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency.
